ACADEMIC AGREEMENT BETWEEN EL COLEGIO DE MEXICO AND THE CENTRE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDIES, OXFORD UNIVERSITY

- 1) The aim of this agreement is to foster research and graduate teaching within the field of International Relations. The major focus will be in the following fields:

a) Growth and significance of regionalism in international relations. The role of regional organisations and arrangements in the economic, political and security fields of Mexico and other countries in Latin America.

b) Attitudes and policies of states and groups of states towards international organisations. National approaches to domestic, regional and international order; responses of states to international norms; and the relationship between national and international norms.

- 2) Among the main activities contemplated in this agreement is the organisation of workshops and conferences related to the topics mentioned above. The scholars taking part in those events will belong to any of the institutions or will be jointly invited by them.

- 3) This agreement is also intended to provide a context for visiting academic affiliation (but not necessarily either accommodation or office space) for visits of up to two academic terms.

a) El Colegio de México would in principle welcome up to one visiting professor from the Centre for International Studies, for periods to be determined in each case but normally not exceeding two academic terms.

b) The Centre for International Studies would in principle welcome each year up to one visiting professor from El Colegio de México for periods to be determined in each case but normally not exceeding two academic terms.

c) Both parties to the agreement will make every effort to help arrange accommodation for visiting academics. However, each party to the agreement will seek funding to cover the travelling and maintenance costs of the academics of its respective institution.

d) Each party to the agreement would submit to the other the names of possible visiting professors at least six months before the proposed visit. The host institution has the right to accept or reject the proposed visiting professor.

e) Visiting professors are expected to offer seminars on their research and to participate generally in the academic activities of the host institution.

- 4) Both parties to the agreement will assist each other in seeking temporary admission for visiting students in their respective institutions. Under no circumstances will students who are admitted through this agreement be able to pursue formal studies in any of the institutions.
- 5) Both parties to the agreement will exchange full information about their academic plans, activities, publications and visiting scholars.
- 6) This agreement will remain in force for an initial period of three years and may be renewed or amended by mutual consent.
